How do I know where under this big “umbrella” I should stand?

✝ **Infant Baptism** is for me if:

I am a parent or guardian of a child newborn to age 7, desiring the sacrament of Baptism for my child? We have a wonderful team of volunteers in our Baptism ministry, happy to assist parent and guardians with this process.

✝ **RCIA / OCIA (Rite / Order of Christian Initiation for Adults)** is for me if:

I am an adult, interested in the Roman Catholic faith. I am not baptized, OR I have received only the sacrament of Baptism in the Roman Catholic faith but have gone no further in faith enrichment or sacraments, OR I am baptized in another Christian faith and am seeking the path of Catholic Christianity. We have a wonderful team of volunteers in our RCIA / OCIA ministry.

✝ **RCIA / OCIA (Rite / Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) ADAPTED for youth is for me if:**

I am over the age of 7 and not baptized, OR I am an older teen having received only the sacrament of Baptism in the Roman Catholic faith, OR I am an older teen baptized in another Christian faith and am seeking the path of Catholic Christianity.

✝ **Ongoing Religious Education / Domestic Church model is for me if:**

I am part of a family raising children in the Catholic faith. I want all members of my family to continue to learn and grow in the faith. I want separate classroom opportunities for my children/grandchildren in age-appropriate settings. But I also want opportunities for myself in adult learning settings. And I want opportunities for our entire family to learn together with other families, as well as within our own domestic church in the home.
