- 1. Choose Family Resources
- 2. Select Grade / Resource Level
- 3. Scroll down to see Units (Sessions Games)
 - a. Each session offers an interactive session review (this is ultimately an "assessment" even though it is not labeled as such)
 - b. Click the interactive session review for each session. At the end of each, you will be given an option to email results.
 - c. After the interactive session reviews, you will see "fishers of faith". This is an overview of the entire unit, "assessed" in a game format. It is interactive, fun, and enriching. While results of this cannot be emailed, it is a great way to wrap up the unit review.
